Academic Excellence

SRN continues its legacy of holistic education and top-tier academic accomplishments. The school achieved 100% pass results in CBSE Board examinations for both Classes X and XII. Class X achievers include Diksha Choudhary (97.8%), Pranav Vikrant (97.4%), and Amogh Chouhan (97.2%) followed by many achievers like Aditi Chapola, Ayush Devacha, Peeval Shekhawat or Saskshi Sharma. In Class XII, Kritika Singh topped Science with 98.6%, Aditi Agarwal led Commerce with 97.4%, and Angel Sharma excelled in Humanities with 98.2%. Many students surpassed 95%, with numerous distinctions in Fine Arts, Psychology, Indian Vocal Music, and AI. Alumni advanced to premier institutes through competitive exams like JEE, NEET, NIFT, and CA entrance, CDS and CLAT and have sought admission to the renowned institutions of our country. Innovation & Interdisciplinary Learning

Exhibition, Annual function and multiple activities empowered students to present interdisciplinary projects that merged science, art, and technology. Winning teams showcased 21st-century skills in robotics, coding, entrepreneurship, and financial literacy, securing accolades such as MNIT Innovation Challenge and ATL of the Month for the consecutive 6 months. Entrepreneur and Development Cell of our school has been instrumental in letting students explore and achieve. Our students, Yashi Gupta, Sakshi Sharma and Swasti Gehlot participated in the Business Plan Competition and grabbed the cash prize of 25,000/- in the Ideathon competition organised by Laghu Udyog Bharat, 5100/- in another competition organised by Poddar Institute of Management, and 2500/- in the Futurepreneur Competition for their innovative and thoughtful project Signo. In fact, our students have also grabbed the prize money of 2 Lakhs rupees for another two creative and insightful projects, Blaze Out and Seismic Detector. With this seed money, students are working on their prototype. Our school had been the proud winner of CBSE National level Science exhibition for presenting Smart Village and CBSE Regional Level Science Exhibition for smart ATM and Li-Fi.

Co-curricular and Sporting Highlights

SRN students excelled at district and national levels in skating, athletics, shooting, volleyball, and lawn tennis. Shikha Choudhary represented India at the International Shooting Championship in Peru, and Somil Choudhary won a medal in Junior World Cup under 25 m Pistol held at New Delhi. Our stars Paras & Shivaay grabbed the Gold and Silver medal in CBSE West Zone Skating Tournament and at the National level. Debaters and public speakers earned first position at interstate contests, and cultural teams brought accolades in music, dance, and drama.

Infrastructure Upgradation
